

## The Impact of Lower Face on Facial Beautification with Fillers

Lower face has a vital importance in the perception of facial beauty. In order to enhance the attractiveness of the face in both genders, the initial assessment is critical. Mandibule acts like a picture frame separating the lower face from the midface. This separation can be augmented by using hyaluronic acid fillers with higher cohesivity. The injection anatomy and precise injection areas/points are also as critical as the rheology of the product that is preferred. Anterior, posterior or the whole jawline can be addressed with fillers with various impacts. For younger patients the aim is more beautification whereas for others the impact on age management is ore important. In either case lower face is an area which requires particular attention from physicians who deals with nonsurgical aesthetics.

### Biography:

Reha Yavuzer was graduated from Anakara University Faculty of Medicine in 1992 with an honorary degree. He had his Plastic Surgery training between 1992 and 1998 at Gazi University Faculty of Medicine. Between 1998 and 1999 He has completed Craniofacial Clinical Fellowship program at Institute for Craniofacial Surgery under Dr Ian T Jackson, in USA. He became Assistant Professor in 2001; Associate Professor in 2004 and full Professor 2010. He is currently holding academic position at Koc University School of Medicine, Department of Plastic Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgery in Istanbul Turkey. Together with his wife he established "René Clinic" which has holistic approach to beauty and age management in 2013. Dr. Yavuzer has both international and national publications exceeding more than 140 papers which received more than 400 citations. He also had more than 200 presentations and lectures in various plastic surgery meetings. He conducted several workshops and hands-on trainings for various subjects of plastic surgery mostly on breast surgery, rhinoplasty, maxillofacial surgery; minimally invasive aesthetic procedures such as neurotoxin and filler techniques. Dr. Yavuzer holds several membership positions in international and national societies in the field of plastic and aesthetic surgery. He is currently a member of Executive Committee and acts as Secretary General of Turkish Aesthetic Surgery Society.
